



2021 Academic Scholarships Application Instructions

Each Scholarship Application *must be typed* with the following information:

- 1. Your name, mailing address, telephone number, and e-mail address.
- 2. The name and address of your educational institution.
- 3. Your current academic program, major, GPA, and expected graduation date (mm/yyyy).
- 4. One or two paragraphs about your career objectives and goals.
- 5. Your extra-curricular activities and clubs, including those related to your major/career goals (i.e. WIFT / IFT involvement).
- 6. Your related work experience current job, work/study, or summer internships (paid or unpaid).
- 7. Earned academic awards and honors.
- 8. One or two paragraphs about your involvement with the WIFT, IFTSA, and IFT.
- 9. *For graduate applicants only,* please provide a statement of your research interests.

Each WIFT Scholarship Application <u>must</u> also include the following:

- 1. A college/university academic transcript showing course work completed to date. (An official transcript is not necessary)
- 2. Two letters of reference.
