



# 2021 Academic Scholarships Application Instructions

Each Scholarship Application must be typed with the following information:

1. Your name, mailing address, telephone number, and e-mail address.
2. The name and address of your educational institution.
3. Your current academic program, major, GPA, and expected graduation date (mm/yyyy).
4. One or two paragraphs about your career objectives and goals.
5. Your extra-curricular activities and clubs, including those related to your major/career goals (i.e. WIFT / IFT involvement).
6. Your related work experience – current job, work/study, or summer internships (paid or unpaid).
7. Earned academic awards and honors.
8. One or two paragraphs about your involvement with the WIFT, IFTSA, and IFT.
9. *For graduate applicants only*, please provide a statement of your research interests.

Each WIFT Scholarship Application must also include the following:

1. A college/university academic transcript showing course work completed to date.  
(An official transcript is not necessary)
2. Two letters of reference.
