Description

DuPont Nutrition & Health has an exciting opportunity for you to join our team as a **Production Process Operator** in Madison, Wisconsin.

The position will be responsible for, but not limited to the following:

- Mix, blend and formulate materials according to established formulas, procedures and quality standards.
- Operate production equipment and production tools such as heating and cooling batch tanks, batch/blend tanks, freezers, scales, gauges, forklifts, pelletizers, packaging equipment, CIP/COP systems and autoclaves.
- Monitor the status of the production processes, i.e. oxygen monitoring, collecting lab samples, monitoring temperature, pressure, pH, weights, volumes, taking measurements, interpreting charts and recording data.
- Follow standard operating procedures (SOPs) and Work Instructions to make necessary adjustments in the production process, i.e. adjusting control instruments, moving products, adding raw materials, etc.
- Recognize atypical/incorrect conditions in the production area and escalate as necessary. Adjust conditions outside SOPs and normal operational parameters, if necessary.
- Maintain accurate written records or logs of all production processes/equipment maintenance/routine cleaning.
- Monitor machinery and equipment to ensure functionality and make minor mechanical adjustments as necessary. Perform routine preventative maintenance and bring to attention any major adjustments or repair work.
- Assemble and disassemble production equipment as required by processes.
- Clean, sanitize and sterilize all production/packaging equipment and other process areas in the plant. Prepare materials for blending: weigh and mix raw materials in accordance with the batch tickets specifications. Use filling equipment in accordance with batch ticket specifications.
- Prepare materials for sterilization: weigh and mix raw materials in accordance with specifications and fill equipment with appropriate materials.
- Ensure adherence to all quality systems including, ISO 9001, FSSC 22000, and Food Safety with an understanding of DuPont's Quality Policy and procedures.
- Compliance with all Company policies including, but not limited to: Quality, Safety, Food Safety, Environmental, GMP's, HAACP, Early Reporting of Pain, and Attendance.

This is a full-time position, working a 12 hour night shift schedule with rotating weekends.

Availability to work the following schedule is required:

Thursday: 12am/1am - 6am/7am & 6pm/7pm - 6am/7am

Friday: 6pm/7pm - 6am/7am

Saturday/Sunday: 6pm/7pm - 6am/7am (alternates bi-weekly)
